The NYS OASAC requirement of additional hours of volunteer and paid experience as a CASAC eligible counselor before sitting for the exam varies depending on your academic degree at the time of application.

NOTES:

•Courses must be taken together.

It is recommended that Liberal Arts and Humanities courses be taken in summer sessions. (i.e., Composition & Literature, Psychology, Sociology, Spanish, History, etc.) Alcohol & Substance Abuse and the Family may also be taken during the summer.

Current employment may be used as fieldwork with the approval of the Curriculum Chair and the Field Coordinator.

Addiction Counseling Methods (formally - Alcohol & Substance Abuse Counseling I) - written permission required from the Curriculum Chair.

- **Humanities** courses include Art, Dance, Drama, Music, Foreign Language, Film, Philosophy, Theater & Photography courses at ARTWS.

¹ Offered during the first summer session in the evenings.

² Offered only in the Fall Semester and in the evening. Two Prerequisites (a) Biochemistry of Addiction and (b) Alcohol, Substance Abuse and the Family or Psychosocial Issues in Addiction. The only requirement is written permission from the curriculum chair who will determine whether the students meets the qualifications

³ Offered only in the Spring semester. Addiction Group Counseling in the late afternoon & Counseling Models in the evening.
