NOTES:

All English courses have prerequisites.

Composition & Literature 1 & 2 are prerequisites for all other English courses (except Creative Writing, Reading and Writing Poetry for which Composition and Literature I is the prerequisite).

All Communications courses receive English credit, **except** broadcasting production courses (i.e. Radio Production, TV Production 1 & 2, and all internships and newspaper production courses).

- ***Behavioral Science*** courses include Sociology, Psychology, Anthropology and Geography. General Psychology is the prerequisite for all upper level psychology courses.
- ***Social Science*** courses include History, Political Science, Economics and Geography.
- ***Humanities*** courses include Art, Dance, Drama, Music, Film, Foreign Language, Literature¹, Philosophy, Theater and Photography at ARTWS

¹ Students may take no more than 6 literature credits to satisfy the Humanities requirement.

² A minimum of one foreign language course, at any level, is required.
