- ***Humanities*** courses include Art, Dance, Drama, Music, Foreign Language, Film, Philosophy, Theater and Photography at ARTWS.

**Students are advised to take ENG 101 Comp & Lit 1 in their first semester before taking Behavioral/ Social Science courses.**

<sup>1</sup> College Algebra, Contemporary Math and Development of Math Thought may not transfer to all institutions to fulfill mathematics requirements. They may transfer as free electives. Therefore, Finite Mathematics, College Algebra with Trigonometry and Statistics (or higher) are recommended.

<sup>2</sup> Social Science students must take at least one course in each of three different disciplines, choosing among anthropology, economics, history, geography, political science, psychology, and sociology. **SS 101, SS 102 and ECON 110 DO NOT COUNT AS A SOCIAL SCIENCE OR BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE ELECTIVE.**
