**Fall only:** Introduction to Nutrition Care, Nutrition Care I, Foods and Foods Lab, Clinical Nutrition, Clinical Practicum 2

**Spring only:** Nutrition Care 2, Clinical Practicum 1, Principles of Teaching Health Care, Dietetic Seminar-Nutrition, Food Service Systems Management, Clinical Practicum 3

- **Humanities** courses include Art, Dance, Drama, Music, Film, Foreign Language, Philosophy, Theater and Photography courses at ARTWS.
- **Social Science** courses include History, Political Science, Economics and Geography.

<sup>1</sup> Nutrition Care I - Must be ready to take college level mathematics and Composition & Literature 1.

<sup>2</sup> Nutrition Care I is prerequisite for Nutrition Care 2. Nutrition Care 2 and Clinical Practicum 1 are co-requisites. If only one course can be taken it must be Nutrition Care 2.

<sup>3</sup> Contemporary Mathematics is acceptable.

<sup>4</sup> Nutrition Care 1 & 2, Anatomy & Physiology 1&2 are prerequisite for Clinical Nutrition. Clinical Nutrition and Clinical Practicum 2 are co-requisites. If only one course can be taken it must be Clinical Nutrition.

<sup>5</sup> Clinical Practicum 1 is prerequisite for Clinical Practicum 2.

<sup>6</sup> Clinical Practicum 2 is prerequisite for Clinical Practicum 3. Food Service Systems management and Clinical Practicum 3 are co-requisites. If only one course can be taken it must be Food Service Systems management.
