    ${ }^{2}$ Nutrition Care I is prerequisite for Nutrition Care 2. Nutrition Care 2 and Clinical Practicum 1 are co-requisites. If only one course can be taken it must be Nutrition Care 2.
    ${ }^{3}$ Contemporary Mathematics is acceptable.
    ${ }^{4}$ Nutrition Care $1 \& 2$, Anatomy \& Physiology 1\&2 are prerequisite for Clinical Nutrition. Clinical Nutrition and Clinical Practicum 2 are co-requisites. If only one course can be taken it must be Clinical Nutrition.
