Additionally, at least one of the following courses must be among those taken here, and both must have been completed within five years of applying for the degree: **ACC 203**, **ACC 204**.

³ College level math is a strongly suggested co-requisite for **ACC 119**-Financial Accounting. **Financial Accounting should be taken in the first semester possible since there are four consecutive accounting courses.**

⁴ Managerial Accounting – Computer Competency is desirable or **CIS 110**-Computer Information Systems should be taken in the first or second semester.

⁵ Recommend: **CIS 110**-Computer Information Systems ahead of **ACC 120**-Managerial Accounting and **MKT 101**-Marketing.
