FAQs

- → When is the time to apply to the program? The best time to apply is when you are confident ready and willing to submit your application materials for the work ahead. You can apply to the program for admissions during the months of December March. The deadline to receive the application is March 1 annually. Records are reviewed after the deadline date. Your decision should be based on what is best for you.
 - → Is a test required for the Rad Tech Program? No. The minimal standards are listed above in this document.
- → What is the best thing I could be doing prior to preparing/applying for the Rad Tech Program? While in High School, explore health careers to gain exposure to the different health care pathways. Go to the professional health care web sites and see what interests you. Take challenging courses and develop effective study habits. This can help you become more prepared of what to expect in the college setting.
- → When does the program start and what are the hours of attendance? The program starts in September of each year. Junior Year: Hours of attendance for clinical are 8 hours, 2 x week. Classroom hours are 3 x week. As a general rule, students attend clinical rotation 8am –4pm & 9am –4pm for classroom hours.
