**COMSC 101-Computer Programming I:** The Co requisite for COMSC 101 is MATH 181 or higher. The Prerequisite for COMSC 101 is a Reading Placement score >= 80 or a passing grade in READ 105.

**COMSC 100-Intro to Computing Concepts:** Students who need to take developmental courses, and so are ineligible to take COMSC 101, should take COMSC 100. It is a good alternative for students who are trying to decide between CS, CIS, Networking, or Computer Arts. Students who have never used a computer, not even for email, the internet or word processing should also take this course before taking COMSC 101.
